Your company has been assigned Carrier Number CA **385546** in the California Highway Patrol's Management Information System of Terminal Evaluation Records (MISTER). This is an automated file pertaining to motor carriers operating in the State of California. MISTER gives the CHP immediate access to emergency information about your company. It also allows the CHP to make better use of its inspection personnel by monitoring the overall safety operations of carriers. This is done by collecting information regarding citations, traffic accidents, hazardous material spills, and terminal evaluation ratings.

Your assigned Carrier Number must be displayed according to Vehicle Code Section 34507.5 (e.g., on both sides of at least one vehicle in a combination as described in Section 34500, any motortruck of two or more axles that is more than 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating, or any other motortruck or motor vehicle used to transport property for compensation). Carriers displaying any one of the following valid numbers on their vehicle(s) are not required to display a CA number: a CAL-T number issued by the California Public Utilities Commission to household goods carriers; a TCP or PSC number issued by the California Public Utilities Commission to passenger carriers; or a US DOT number issued by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), to truck and passenger carriers. The number must be legible from 50 feet during normal daylight hours (approximately two inches high) and in a contrasting color to the background.
